Albion Street Group Practice is situated in Rotherhithe. It serves a population of over 10,000 patients. There is an interesting demographic in the area. There are well established working class families who have been here since the times of working dock yards, a significant immigrant population mainly from West Africa and Eastern Europe, and a young professional population due to the close proximity of Canary Warf.

There are 9 partners in total, 8 doctors and a nurse practitioner. On top of this there are 3 practice nurses, a health care assistant, a practice counsellor and a well established team of receptionist and administrators. There are no salaried doctors employed at the practice.

There is a strong tradition of education at the practice with 2 qualified GP trainers, Dr Catherine Otty and Dr Barry Marsh and a third in training, Dr Raj Nair who is also a programme director on the St Thomas VTS. One of the partners, Prof Brendan Delaney, is a professor of General Practice at King's providing a strong academic link. As well as training GP registrars they also take medical students from all levels as well as F2 doctors.

It's a friendly, welcoming practice where trainees are made to feel part of the team.
