

Lambeth Walk Group Practice is located in Lambeth, close to the Imperial War Museum. It is within the congestion zone and there is some parking available, although the doctors all cycle or walk to work and home visits.

The 7800 patients are a mixed inner city population. There are two partners, three salaried GPs, one nurse practitioner, one practice nurse, a healthcare assistant, a data coordinator, a manager, two secretaries and several receptionists.

The practice has two GP trainers - King's College final year medical students are present for 8-week blocks over the year, there is a trainee GP assistant from St George's and an ST2/3 GP trainee throughout the year. There is a weekly clinical meeting, often with guest speakers and once a month, the practice closes for protected learning where other practices join them for teaching/ training.

The people at Lambeth Walk are friendly, supportive, and well organised with good practice records. Help is always to hand should you need it.
